Multimedia Project Management

 - Under Title III of the Older Americans Act – National Family Caregiver Support Programs. Grants totaled \$143,464 (project # 561002 contract # EX0233).
 - Matching funds by the State of Colorado and The Rose Family Foundation. Administered by the Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG).
 - Wrote and produced a series of news and informational segments for broadcast on radio and television. The content gave caregiver tips and resource information to help in the care of an aging loved one.
